## The Duncan DuPre House

This Spartanburg landmark serves as an exceptional architectural piece of Spartanburgs past. It reflects fine design and craftsmanship. It is sided with

clapboard, cedar shingles, has six chimneys for twelve fireplaces, a slate roof and holds original fixtures. The DuPre House was built in 1885-86 by Bishop William Wallace Duncan. He and his wife Medora Rice Duncan had three children. Their daughter Caroline Duncan DuPre and her husband Warren Dupre took ownership of the home



in Greenville, SC will open its doors for the public the first time on Saturday, September 29th, 2007.

The museum will have permanent exhibits, oral history presentations and student enrichment programs, but will also invite visitors not only to discover the Upcountry's past, but to participate in telling its story.
